

# THE EIGHT COMMITTEES

---

## ***Security council (SC):***

This council is about combatting the sabotage of key infrastructure using cyberspace, trying to provide stability in the Horn of Africa and forming a procedure for quarantining countries that pose a public health risk to the rest of the world.

## ***Disarmament and International Security (GA1):***

The first thing this council focusses on is drafting a blueprint for the withdrawal of the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP) in comprehension with Cypriot-Turkish peace talks. Short sighted: They are debating about whether they should unite or divide Cyprus. They also talk about the current situation in Afghanistan and the Integral security in the Black-Sea region.



## ***Social, Cultural and Humanitarian (GA3):***

The main subject of this meeting is to talk about the role of religious rituals and gatherings during epidemics. For example, if people can gather with big groups in churches or mosques during the corona period. Secondly, they try to find a balance between protecting cultural heritage and recognizing past injustices. For example, protecting cultural heritage, that remind to European slavery in the past. They also talk about combatting institutional complacency towards violence against indigenous minorities in Latin America.

## ***Special Political and Decolonization (GA4):***

This council is about the political influence of multinationals on domestic policies, a region in Syria, called the Golan Heights. The region is currently occupied by the Israeli forces and the third thing the council is about, is the rising tension in the South China Sea region.

## ***Human Rights Council (HRC):***

Here they talk about the balance between the right for privacy and public health, the role and responsibility of multinational companies in moderating online behavior and ensuring the human rights of the Roma in Europe.

## ***United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP):***

In this council they handle the question of the environmental impact of the internet. They speculate about combatting the environmental impact of armed conflict in Afghanistan. And third about enforcing the ban on the use of mercury in mining. So, in short, this is all about nature and wanting to save the planet.

## ***Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC):***

The first thing this council focusses on is reviewing direct monetary aid as opposed to conditional aid to people living in poverty, so that these people do not have to wait any longer for help. They also handle the Global Code of Ethics for Tourism and the Human rights violations in the palm oil industry.

## ***European Council (EC):***

This council talks about the current state of freedom of press in Hungary and Poland, the repatriation of foreign fighters in ISIL and they review the EU Emissions Trading System to realize net zero carbon emissions.
